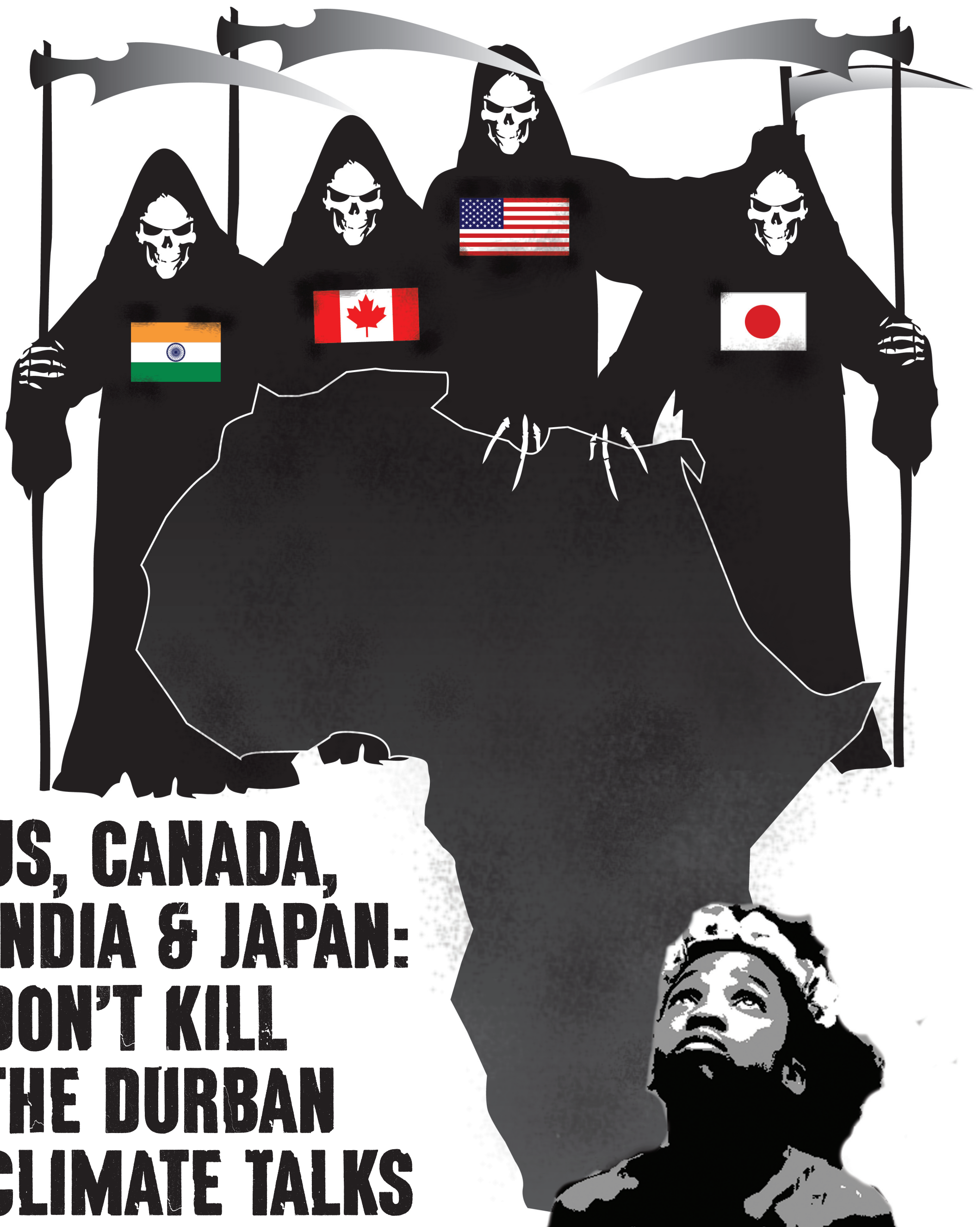


# WILL THEY SIGN AFRICA'S DEATH SENTENCE?
